- *VOLUNTEERS* – Assisting with younger programs, lead book clubs, mentor others, assist updating library social media. See p9 of the Teen Manual for more ideas
- *PUBLICIZE* – school announcements, fliers and posters; local radio, TV and social media; at your library using posters, fliers, bookmarks and word-of-mouth; teen clubs and organizations, local churches, shopping centers, restaurants, video arcades, homeless centers, family resource centers and justice departments
- *INVITE THEM* – create a mailing or mobile text list or email list and send program updates
