YALSA Book Award and Selected Book & Media Lists - while you should look at all of the awarded, finalist, honored and selected book and media lists there are lists you can pay special attention. The Printz Award which is for the best book for young adults which is not synonymous with popular book. These award books and finalists are critically reviewed and should stand up to multiple readings. The Best Fiction for Young Adult (BFYA) selection list is curated by nominations from librarians and students. The same is said for Great Graphic Novels (GG) and Quick Picks for Reluctant Readers (QP) selection lists. QP is perfect for introducing titles for non-readers. If you want to see what these selection committees are currently considering, BFYA, GG and QP, periodically check their current nominations list. Others are the Nonfiction Award because not all teens like fiction and Morris Award for debut Young Adult Authors for those teens who like to live on the edge and discover new voices.
